Job Title: Outside Plant (OSP) Technician

SUMMARY: An Outside Plant (OSP) technician is responsible for constructing the outside plant (aerial, underground, and buried copper and fiber) necessary to provide services to customers.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Place, splice, maintain, and remove aerial, underground, and buried copper and fiber telecommunication plant, including pedestals, poles, repeaters, etc.

Use, properly care for, and maintain equipment appropriate to the job (e.g., digger truck, backhoe, trencher, etc.).

Read, interpret, and modify (as applicable) cable transfers and engineering prints.

Performs preventative and routine maintenance, as well as, troubleshoots telecom problems when necessary.

Attend regular training to stay current on industry developments as needed.

All other related duties as required and/or assigned.
